In an effort to improve our service to the residents and customers of the Town of Holderness, the Holderness Board of Selectmen is pleased to announce our new MapsOnline website (www.mapsonline.net/holdernessnh).

MapsOnline is a new and exciting town-wide mapping system offering access to a number of mapping layers specific to the Town of Holderness, including buildings, roads, water bodies, wetlands, aerial photography, and more. All of these layers can be turned on and off over the town's parcel mapping, providing users with a unique set of mapping capabilities. The website also offers limited Assessor's information for individual properties.

MapsOnline is an extension of the Town's mapping system, also called a Geographical Information System (GIS). Because MapsOnline is a web-based software system, the Town is able to provide GIS-access to all departments and staff at low cost. Additionally, the use of MapsOnline enables the Town to extend the GIS to the general public.

MapsOnline was developed by PeopleGIS (www.peoplegis.com) of Concord, MA. Currently over 40 communities are using MapsOnline, including 12 communities in New Hampshire.

The Holderness Selectmen encourage the public's use of Holderness MapsOnline and look forward to receiving comments from users about this valuable information system.
